3. One entry is permitted per classroom

The winning school will be randomly drawn on 10 November 2020.

Competition Period	The Competition starts at 9:00am AEST 7 September 2020. The Competition closes at 11:59pm AEST 10 November 2020. No entries will be accepted after this time.

Relevant State	Queensland
Eligibility requirements for participants	School teachers from Queensland schools can enter on behalf of their class/school. Only one entry can be submitted per classroom. Multiple entries can be submitted for each school.
Entry Method	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Teachers download the Get Ready activity sheets from the competition website at www.getready.qld.gov.au/schools.• Students are invited to colour in and personalise their pledge activities and display these a 'get ready wall' in the classroom• Teachers are to take a picture of their classroom 'get ready wall' and submit that picture as an entry via the competition website.• All valid entries received will be placed into a random electronic prize draw.
Prize Pool Details	The first and only prize is a two-hour school visit from Johnathan Thurston. A short video of the visit and the winning entry will be made and promoted on www.getready.qld.gov.au
Draw Details	Competition draw to be held at 11:00am AEST 10 November 2020.

	Competition redraw (if applicable) to be held at 11:00am AEST 13 November 2020.
Notification of Winner	The winning school will be contacted by an email sent by the QRA. The results will also be published at www.getreadyqld.gov.au/schools from 16 November 2020.
Publication Details	Each school entrant agrees to QRA publishing the name of the winning school and using photographs and videos taken from Johnathan Thurston's visit to promote the Get Ready Queensland message. Prior to the visit, the winning school will ensure it has consent for any student or staff that is to be included in the photographs and video. Media may be invited to the visit. Before doing so QRA will obtain approval from the school principal.
Unclaimed Prize Redraw Date	If the winning school cannot be notified or is unwilling or unable to meet the requirements of the visit, QRA may redraw the Competition on 13 November 2020. The results of the redraw will be emailed to the winner by QRA and published at www.getreadyqld.gov.au/schools from 19 November 2020.
Winner selection	There are no skill or elimination rounds in the Competition. All valid entries received will be placed into a random electronic prize draw.
Prize Delivery	The timing of the Johnathan Thurston school visit will be coordinated with the winning school at a mutually convenient time and date. The date for the visit may be delayed if an event beyond the reasonable control of Johnathan Thurston or QRA means the visit on the agreed date cannot occur.
