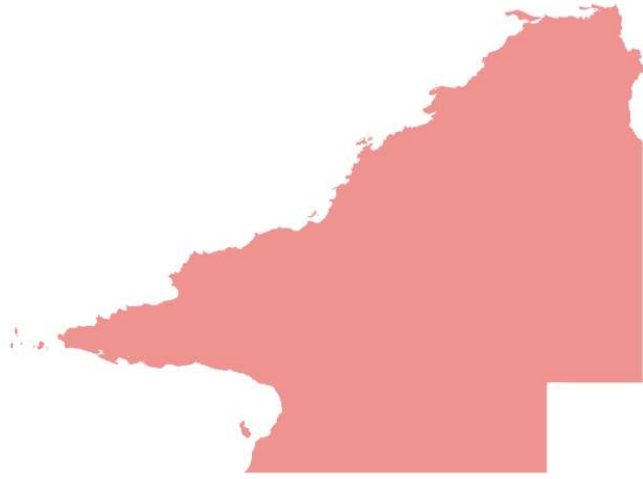

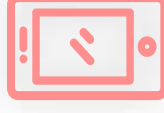

Get Ready Queensland undertook state-wide market research in 2022 to understand Queenslanders' attitudes about their disaster risk and steps they have taken to prepare.

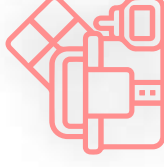
History shows us that disasters can happen anywhere in Queensland with little warning such as a sudden severe storm that destroys homes, a drought breaking flood or a bushfire.

In the past decade, Queensland has been impacted by 97 significant natural disaster events and \$20 billion has been placed for relief, recovery and reconstruction works.

62% have an emergency plan



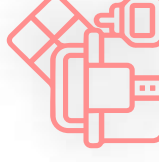
