- 1 Landslides are large amounts of dirt, rock or mud sliding out of place that can damage buildings, roads and the environment.
- 2 Landslides can happen after heavy rain.
- 3 Signs that a landslide might happen can be:
 - Damage to building walls or cracks in plaster, tiles or bricks
 - Cracks getting bigger in pathways or roads
 - Fences, walls, power poles or trees bending over
- 4 If you think a landslide might happen soon, call "000".
- 5 Leave the area quickly.
- 6 **Get ready:** go to your local council or the Get Ready Queensland web pages to find an emergency plan you can do.
